

Core Beliefs

- The heavenly Father, His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit are eternal, unique personalities, within one being—God Almighty, the Creator, the Lord of all.
- God created the heavens and the earth with His almighty power and awesome creativity. In the future, in God's time, this will be destroyed and replaced by a new heaven and a new earth untouched by sin or defilement.

Since He knows us intimately and has been with us since He created us, we seek His generous, heavenly riches as we ask Him to reveal His love and truth for the answers we all need to heal the deepest broken places in our hearts and lives. We trust Him to lead us to the origins of our wounds and listen to His healing messages for us replacing the lies with truth. HE is our Healer. We quietly wait for Him to reveal how healing is to occur for each person. We praise Him and thank Him for His abundant compassion and mercy for us.
